#### Comments:

The Herbert region's 2022 crushing season commenced on Tuesday 14 June at both Victoria and Macknade mills.

Daily throughput gradually increased during the week as field conditions improved. A total of 96,051 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week.

With school holidays commencing at the end of this week, parents and carers are urged to remind children of the dangers associated with cane trains. Children should keep well away from the cane rail network and never play on or around cane bins.

Motorists and cyclists should approach cane rail crossings with caution, and always give way to cane trains.

Motorists should be particularly vigilant at rail crossings in rural areas, where visibility may be limited by standing cane.
