Persistent showers throughout the Herbert region brought crushing to a stop at Macknade Mill on Friday, with Victoria Mill ceasing late on Sunday.

As a result, crushing throughput was limited to 162,167 tonnes of cane for the week.

CCS levels have been suppressed due to the wet conditions, with the weekly average at 11.14 units.

During this forced downtime, we will undertake factory maintenance.

Despite the wet weather, cane trains may still be moving around the district. With school holidays still under way, parents and carers are urged to speak to their children about the need to stay well away from cane trains, cane bins and cane rail corridors.
