#### Comments:

The Herbert mills crushed close to 206,600 tonnes of cane for the week and have now passed the season milestone for the first million tonnes crushed.

More than a quarter of the newly re-estimated crop has now been processed.

There was an increase of .06 of a unit of CCS for the second week in a row to take the season-to-date average to 12.01 units.

Both Victoria and Macknade mills had 12-hour maintenance stops during the week.

This week Victoria's A-side shredder will have a four-hour maintenance stop on Monday 8 August and a 12-hour cleaning intermission on B-side on Tuesday 9 August.

There was a near hit last week when a water truck failed to give way at a cane rail crossing.

We once again appeal to all road users to approach level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
