#### Comments:

Just over 202,500 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week. This was a very reasonable effort considering there were two maintenance stops and a sugar train derailment that caused a temporary stop in production until the line was cleared.

CCS levels continue to slowly improve, achieving 12.59 units average for the week – up 0.2 units from the previous week.

The season-to-date CCS remains under budget at 11.82 units.

With wet conditions impacting harvesting operations early this week, the Herbert mills will utilise any cane supply shortfalls to undertake scheduled maintenance at both factories.

As always, please approach all cane rail crossings with caution and use your train brain.
