Just over 183,300 tonnes of cane was processed for the week – a good result given Macknade Mill stopped crushing early in the week due to wet weather.

The Herbert mills have now crushed more than 2 million tonnes of cane.

CCS levels remain below budget with the season-todate CCS sitting at 11.88 units.

Victoria Mill will undertake a 16-hour maintenance and cleaning intermission stop on B-side on Tuesday 13 September. Macknade Mill will undertake a four-hour shredder stop on Thursday 15 September.
