#### Comments:

Weekly throughput exceeded 204,500 tonnes of cane, despite Victoria Mill stopping for a B-side cleaning intermission and to repair a leaking boiler tube.

Victoria Mill has passed the 1.5M tonnes milestone, and the Herbert mills have collectively processed more than 2.3M tonnes of cane season to date.

Victoria Mill will undertake a 12 hour A-side cleaning intermission on Tuesday 20 September.

CCS levels rose just below half a unit last week however they remain below forecast with the season-to-date CCS sitting at 11.96 units.

With the September school holidays currently in progress we again ask parents and carers to remind children to keep clear of our cane railway network at all times.

There have been reports of early morning fog this week which may cause visibility issues.

Motorists and harvesting contractors are urged to take extra caution while these conditions prevail.
