The Herbert mills crushed a total of 223,487 tonnes of cane for the week, passing the 2.5 million tonne milestone.

There was a slight increase in CCS levels from the previous week, with the season-to-date average remaining below budget, at 12.03 units.

There was a scheduled 14 hour maintenance stop during the week for Victoria's Mills A-side.

This week, Victoria's B-side will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Tuesday 27 September and Macknade Mill will have a 12-hour maintenance stop on Thursday 29 September.
