## Comments:

148,152 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 3.3M tonnes.

Weekly CCS trended down due to seasonal thunderstorms across the Herbert district. Recorded weekly average of 11.35 units with the season-to-date average sitting at 12.07.

The wet weather during the week allowed for maintenance and cleaning intermissions at both factories, resulting in no planned mill stops for this coming week.

There was another near-hit over the weekend when a haulout tipper came into contact with overhead electrical wires near a Wilmar siding. This serves as a reminder of the need for vigilance around power lines and caution near the cane rail network.
