#### Comments:

The Herbert mills crushed 172,859 tonnes of cane for the week.

The season-to-date total is almost 3.5M tonnes, which represents 72 per cent of the estimated crop.

Wet weather has continued to disrupt harvesting and crushing operations.

There was a decrease in CCS levels relative to the adverse weather conditions, with the weekly average at 10.91 and the season-to-date CCS remaining below budget at 12.02 units.

This coming week, we will utilise cane supply gaps to carry out shredder tip stops at both factories.

Remember that any work being undertaken near our cane rail network poses a safety risk. Please communicate any planned work to the traffic office and ensure appropriate signage is used.

Cane trains cannot swerve and cannot stop quickly. A full-laden cane train can take up to a kilometre to come to a complete stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
