#### Comments:

A total of 179,477 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, taking the Herbert district past the 4M tonne milestone.

This was another good effort from the harvesting sector with ongoing wet field conditions.

There was a further decline in CCS levels following rainfall events across the district. CCS for the week was 0.39 of a unit lower than the previous week.

There are no planned maintenance stops for the Herbert Mills this coming week.

With the crushing season extending into the school holiday period, we ask parents and caregivers to talk to children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.

Several near hits with vehicles were recorded by locomotive drivers across the region throughout the week. We remind road users not to linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season, including over the holiday period.
