Comments:

The Herbert mills crushed just over 72,000 tonnes for the week following rainfall across the supply district.

There was a further decline in CCS levels due to wet weather, taking the weekly district average to 9.30 units and the season-to-date average down 0.04 from the previous week to 11.77 units.

There are no planned maintenance stops at the Herbert mills this week.

With the crushing season extending into the school holiday period, we ask parents and caregivers to talk to children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.

Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season, including over the holiday period.
