#### Comments:

A total of just less than 190,000 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week, with an average CCS of 12.29.

Standover and burnt cane has been a limiting factor to the sugar production process. Growers and contractors are urged to have consignment notes filled in accordingly to help the factories process this cane.

Thanks to those growers and contractors who have harvested cane that was limiting visibility around our cane railway crossings. However, there is still poor visibility at some crossings and motorists are reminded to be cautious when approaching all cane railway crossings.

With school holidays under way, parents and carers are urged to warn children not to play on bins or near the cane railway network.

Please remember that cane trains can't swerve and cannot come to a quick stop. Use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
