#### Comments:

The Herbert mills processed 164,773 tonnes of cane for the week.

There was an increase of 0.3 of a unit in CCS levels from the previous week, taking the weekly average to 12.98 units.

The season-to-date CCS is now sitting on 12.55 units.

A failed injection water pipe at Victoria Mill on Friday afternoon resulted in processing restrictions over the weekend while repair works were carried out.

There are no maintenance stops planned for Victoria Mill this coming week, and a four-hour shredder stop is planned for Macknade Mill on Friday 11 August.

We once again appeal to all road users to approach level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
