#### Comments:

The Herbert mills processed 204,670 tonnes of cane for the week.

We have now processed more than 1.5M tonnes of cane for the season to date, which represents more than a third of the total estimated crop.

Average weekly CCS levels remain below budget at 12.97 units, but rose by 0.1 of a unit on the previous week.

Season-to-date CCS also rose slightly by 0.04 of a unit on the previous week, to settle at 12.68 units.

This week Macknade Mill will undertake a planned four-hour shredder stop on Monday 28 August. Victoria Mill A-side will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Tuesday 29 August.

Unfortunately visibility remains poor at some cane rail crossings. Motorists are reminded to approach all crossings with caution, and always give way to cane trains.
