#### Comments:

The Herbert mills processed 171,726 tonnes of cane for the week and have now passed the two million tonnes processed milestone.

Poor-quality standover cane, with both low CCS and purity, caused processing issues at both factories during the week.

CCS levels remained below budget, at 13.25 units, with the season-to-date CCS sitting at 12.80 units.

Victoria Mill will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on B-side on Tuesday, 19 September.
