#### Comments:

The Herbert mills processed a total of 201,473 tonnes of cane for the week, pushing Victoria Mill past the 2M tonne milestone.

Following an estimate review, the forecast crop has been revised down by 70,000 tonnes to 4M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS remains below budget at 13.35 units, and season-to-date CCS remains at 12.96 units.

Victoria Mill's B-side will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Tuesday 16 October.

There was a near hit between a cane train and a vehicle at the Cartwright Street crossing during the week. As the season progresses we urge those who are operating harvesters to take extra care around the cane rail corridor.

Please use your train brain and avoid becoming complacent around railways.
