#### Comments:

The Herbert mills processed just over 189,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 3.6M tonnes.

This reflects a fantastic effort from all sectors of the industry given Macknade Mill undertook two maintenance stops for the week.

There was a slight decrease in CCS levels of 0.09 of a unit from the previous week. The season-to-date average is 13.02 units.

Victoria Mill's B side will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Tuesday 14 November.

Based on revised crop trends, forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting in the Herbert area is currently expected to finish on Wednesday 22 November 2023.
