#### Comments:

Just over 166,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total for the Herbert to almost 519,000 tonnes.

Rainfall of up to 20mm was experienced in some parts of the region which impacted cane supply and forced harvesting groups to move to drier areas.

The main cause of lost time was from industrial action on Wednesday.
