Just over 182,200 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bring the Herbert season-to-date total to more than 1.4M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.79 which was below average. Season-to-date CCS is 12.60.

Rainfall and wet ground conditions continue to impact harvesting groups, leading to some cane supply gaps.

With school holidays beginning this coming Friday (13 September), parents and carers are urged to warn children of the dangers of playing near cane railway lines.
