#### Comments:

Just under 210,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to more than 1.6M tonnes.

The average CCS for the week was 12.64, which is slightly above the season-to-date average.

Further rainfall is forecast for the week, putting the focus on bin deliveries and bin weights to maximise processing availability.
