#### Comments:

More than 63,800 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 97,122 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.08, which is below the season-to-date average of 12.17 units.

Both the Victoria and Macknade factories have settled well after restarting operations following widespread rain last week.
