#### Comments:

Just under 185,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 282,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.20, which is slightly above the season-to-date average of 12.19 units.

The factories are settling in after the recent rain stop. Cane quality is good overall, however, there have been a few rakes of low-quality cane delivered that caused factory chokes and reduced crush rates.

Our logistics team is working with growers and harvesting contractors to improve cane quality and requesting that bin tickets be used to identify any issues.

Now that the school holidays have commenced, we ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.

Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains are working 24 hours.
