#### Comments:

About 161,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to more than 615,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.43, which is above the season-to-date average of 12.28 units.

Cane quality remains high overall, however there are still some rakes of low-quality cane causing factory chokes and reduced crush rates.

Our logistics team is requesting that bin tickets be marked to identify any quality issues, even it is only precautionary.

Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
