Comments:

Weekly throughput was restricted to just over 70,000 tonnes due to bin derailments and wet weather. The season-to-date total is now 913,495 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.55, which is above the season-to-date average of 12.37 units.

Cane quality, purity and CCS levels remain pleasingly high, however, there are still some rakes of low-quality cane causing factory chokes and reduced crush rates.

Our logistics team is requesting that bin tickets be marked to identify any issues, even if minor or only precautionary.

We are aware of the impact that recent derailments have had on the field sector. We ask for your patience as we work through these challenges and ask that our people be treated with respect.

Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
