#### Comments:

We've passed the million tonnes crushed milestone for the Herbert region.

Our two factories processed just shy of 189,000 tonnes for the week, bringing the season-to-date to more than 1.1 million tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.87, which is above the season-to-date average of 12.45 units.

Cane quality, purity and CCS levels remain pleasingly high, however, there are increasing reports of elevated mud levels in some samples.

We wish to thank the field sector for their ongoing patience as we settle back into normal operations. We continue to focus on efficient transport schedules despite some of the challenges experienced this season.

Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
