#### Comments:

Just over 204,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 1.63M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.99, which is above the season-to-date average of 12.61 units.

Thanks to those harvesting groups that are identifying flood or standover cane on tickets, as requested. This practice allows the factory to better manage the risk that low-quality cane poses to equipment.

Both factories are planning maintenance days this coming week – Victoria on Tuesday 2 September and Macknade on Thursday 4 September – to address minor emerging issues and carry out general maintenance.

Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
