We've passed the 2M tonnes mark in the Herbert region.

The Herbert mills processed just over 194,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 2.02M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.19 and remains above the season-to-date average of 12.70 units.

I'd like to acknowledge the efforts of growers and harvesting groups in maintaining cane supply to the mills, in the face of wet weather.

We intend to take advantage of the current rain forecast and schedule maintenance work in line with any wet weather stops.

With school holidays coming up, parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
