#### Comments:

The 2026 season kicked off in the Herbert region on 9 June, with the first cane crushed at Victoria Mill just before 5pm.

More than 37,700 tonnes of cane were processed in the first week of operations. Overall throughput was restricted by rainfall in some parts of the district.

Average CCS was 12.35 units, which was above budget.

Thank you to those harvesting groups who were able to supply good quality cane for commissioning our two Herbert factories. Both Victoria and Macknade mills have settled in well,

Rainfall is forecast for later in the week. Please continue to keep in contact with the operations centre if there are any issues with supply.

Please remember to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains are operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
