More than 117,000 tonnes of cane were processed for week two of the 2026 season.

Average weekly CCS was 12.52, which was above budget. The season to date average is sitting on 12.47 units.

Macknade Mill came online at the beginning of week two, but stood down later in the week due to the impact of rain on cane supply. As a result, just over 25,000 tonnes of cane was processed at this site.

Rainfall is forecast for later in the week. Please continue to stay in contact with the operations centre if there are any issues with supply.
