Comments:

Just under 140,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week bringing the season-to-date total to 294,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 12.66 units, which is above the season-to-date average of 12.56.

Wilmar has been advised of some grub damaged cane in the region and ask that all tickets are labelled accordingly for processing.

Rain continued to impact harvesting in the region, with more rain forecast for the coming week.

Due to the reduced loading, Macknade Mill will come online on Sunday 28 June, to allow Victoria Mill to schedule maintenance stops on both A and B sides during the coming week. This will set us up for a good run of processing when the weather clears up and cane supply increases.

With school holidays under way, parents and carers should alert their children to the dangers of playing on or around our cane railway network.

Locals and visitors are also reminded to use their train brain and always give way to cane trains.
