About 148,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 442,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.00 units, which is more than a unit above budget.

Thank you to those groups who continue to mark grub damaged cane on their tickets. This allows us to process the cane accordingly and reduce the risk of damage to the factory.

Rain continues to impact harvesting in the region, in particular Abergowrie, Stone River and Hawkins Creek.

Macknade Mill was brought online on Sunday 28 June, to enable Victoria Mill to complete maintenance stops on both A and B sides. This will place both factories in a strong position to maximise throughput when the weather clears up and cane supply increases.

With school holidays still under way, parents and carers are urged to alert their children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane railway network.

Locals and visitors are also reminded to use their train brain and always give way to cane trains.
