Just over 185,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 627,820 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.15 units, which is more than a unit above budget.

Thank you to the groups who continue to focus on bin weights and supplying clean cane to the factory.

Rain continues to impact harvesting in the region, in particular Abergowrie, Stone River and Hawkins Creek. Weather is forecast to clear next week with groups expected to migrate to the western line.

Macknade Mill is well serviced by groups harvesting in the area, which is reducing pressure on cane transfers between factories.

Despite school holidays finishing this week, we still ask that parents and carers remind their children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane railway network.

Locals and visitors are also urged to use their train brain and always give way to cane trains.
