The Herbert region's 2020 crushing season commenced on Tuesday 23 June at Victoria Mill, with Macknade Mill commencing on Saturday 27 June.

Throughput was restricted due to wet field conditions. A total of 65,550 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week.

With school holidays now under way, parents are asked to remind children of the dangers associated with cane trains. Children should keep well away from the cane rail network and never play on or around cane bins.

We ask motorists and cyclists to take care as they approach any of our cane rail crossings, and always give way to cane trains.

Motorists should be particularly vigilant at rail crossings in rural areas, where visibility may be limited by standing cane.
