Comments:

A total 136,231 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week. Macknade Mill re-commenced crushing operations on Saturday morning, 4 July.

Persistent showers and drizzle resulted in supply falling away in the middle of the week, with full supply still not achievable due to wet field conditions.

Crews took advantage of the forced downtime to carry out caustic cleans and maintenance at both Victoria and Macknade mills.
