Comments:

Good weather conditions saw almost 210,000 tonnes of cane crushed for the week, which is close to budget.

The fine, cool weather also saw CCS levels continue to climb, with a further 0.62 of a unit improvement on the previous week. This pushed the average weekly CCS figure above 12 units for the first time this season.

Victoria Mill will have a B-side milling train maintenance stop on Tuesday 4 August.

Wilmar employees reported more near-hits on our cane rail crossings during the week.

Please remember that cane trains can't swerve and they can't come to a quick stop. Use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
