The Herbert mills crushed a total of 206,431 tonnes of cane for the week and have passed the milestone for the first million tonnes crushed.

More than a quarter of the estimated Herbert crush has now been processed.

Victoria undertook a 12-hour B-side maintenance stop on Tuesday.

There was a very modest 0.08 of a unit improvement in CCS levels on the previous week. The season to date CCS is tracking below the budgeted 12.8 units.

Victoria Mill will have an 11-hour A-side mill cleaning intermission on Tuesday 11 August and Macknade Mill will undertake a 12-hour maintenance stop on Thursday, 13 August.
