#### Comments:

Close to 204,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week.

The season total is now 1.5 million tonnes, putting the Herbert mills more than one-third of the way through the 2020 season.

There was a welcome jump in CCS levels. The 0.51 of a unit improvement saw average weekly CCS eclipse 13 units for the first time this season. The season to date CCS is still tracking below budget, at 11.97 units.

Victoria Mill completed a B-side cleaning intermission on Thursday.

Throughput was impacted earlier in the week due to a widespread power outage caused by a brolga contacting an Ergon transformer. This resulted in a 13-hour stop at Victoria Mill.

Victoria A-side mill will undertake an 11-hour maintenance stop on Tuesday (25 August).
