Comments:

The Herbert mills have now passed the halfway mark for the 2020 crush, with the two million tonnes crushed milestone reached on the evening of Tuesday 8 September.

The total weekly throughput was 212,550 tonnes of cane. This was a solid outcome given Victoria's A-side mill had a 12-hour planned maintenance stop on Wednesday and Macknade Mill had a four-hour stop for shredder tips on Tuesday.

Average CCS levels improved slightly to end the week at 13.68 units. The season to date CCS is now 12.45 units.

This week, Victoria Mill's B-side will have a 12-hour maintenance stop on Wednesday 16 September. A 12-hour maintenance stop is planned for Macknade Mill on Thursday 17 September.

With school holidays due to commence on Friday 18 September, parents and guardians are urged to remind children about the importance of staying well away from train corridors and agricultural operations.
