Comments:

A total of just less than 201,000 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week. Both factories experienced production shortfalls early in the week due to wet weather restricting cane supply.

There was a slight decrease of 0.22 of a unit in CCS levels compared to the previous week.

This week, Victoria B-side will have a four-hour shredder hammer stop on Monday, 28 September, while Victoria Mill A-side will undergo a 12-hour planned maintenance and cleaning intermission on Wednesday, 30 September.

Cane trains continue to operate around the clock. As we enter the second week of school holidays, parents and guardians are urged to remind children to stay well away from our cane rail network.
