Comments:

Just over 210,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week.

Crushing was disrupted at Victoria Mill on Monday for a shredder stop and on Wednesday when A-side was taken offline for a 12-hour scheduled maintenance stop.

Macknade undertook a four-hour shredder stop on Thursday.

Average weekly CCS rose slightly, to end the week at 13.85 units. The season to date CCS is now 12.73 units.

This week, Victoria Mill's B-side will have a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Wednesday 7 October.

Close to 2.7 million tonnes of cane have now been crushed, placing the Herbert at about two thirds of the way through the season.
