Comments:

Wilmar's Herbert mills reached the three million tonnes crushed milestone last week.

Victoria Mill passed the two million tonnes mark and Macknade Mill reached a season total of almost one million tonnes.

Weekly throughput totalled 198,500 tonnes of cane and CCS levels rose slightly to close the week out at just shy of 14 units.

A 12-hour cleaning and maintenance stop was carried out on Victoria's A-side mill on Thursday.

Victoria Mill had a 12-hour unscheduled hour stop overnight on Friday due to a failed coupling on A-side's No. 2 mill.

This week, Macknade Mill will stop for a four-hour shredder stop on Tuesday 20 October and Victoria's B-side mill will undertake a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Thursday 22 October.
