Comments:

Close to 198,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week.

Victoria Mill had a planned maintenance stop on A side on Tuesday, and Macknade Mill had an unscheduled 12-hour stop on Saturday to repair No. 5 Mill pressure feed roller.

During the Macknade stop, crews completed cleaning and maintenance that had been scheduled for this coming Tuesday (3 November).

Victoria's B-side mill will have a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Thursday 5 November.

Growers are urged to compare the physical areas remaining for harvest with what is listed in their field book on the GrowerWeb. Any variations should be reported to Wilmar Sugar on 4776 4390.

Based on the revised estimate of 4.24 million tonnes, the Herbert mills have crushed about 82 percent of the total crop and there are about 740,000 tonnes of cane left to harvest.
