Comments:

About 196,600 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just under 3.7 million tonnes.

Victoria Mill had an unscheduled stop on Wednesday to repair a failed A-side cane carrier. A planned 12-hour maintenance stop for B side was brought forward to Wednesday to maximise the downtime.

CCS increased by almost half a unit, taking the weekly average to 14.19.

Victoria's A-side mill will have a 12-hour cleaning intermission on Thursday 12 November.

Based on an expected final crop of 4.24 million tonnes, no further rain disruptions and normal factory operations, harvesting is currently expected to continue until Saturday 28 November.

Growers are once again urged to compare the physical areas remaining for harvest with what is listed in their field book on the GrowerWeb. Any variations should be reported to Wilmar Sugar on 4776 4390.
