#### Comments:

Just over 192,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, pushing the season-to-date figure above four million tonnes.

Victoria Mill's A-side had a six-hour stop for shredder tip maintenance on Thursday.

There was a slight increase in CCS. The weekly average rose to 14.08 units, and the season-to-date CCS figure increased to 13.16 units.

Based on revised crop trends, forecast throughputs and no rain disruptions, the last day of harvesting for the Herbert mills is expected to be Saturday 28 November.

The finish date will be reviewed daily and we will advise growers of any changes via GrowerWeb.
