The Herbert region's 2020 crushing season was finalised at Victoria Mill on Sunday afternoon.

Harvesting finished on Sunday morning and the last cane was crushed on Victoria's B-side milling train at 2.34pm Sunday.

In line with the agreed staggered finish to the season, Victoria's A-side milling train finalised crushing operations on Saturday morning, with Macknade wrapping up at 7.30am Sunday.

A combined total of 4,250,399 tonnes of cane were crushed for the season.

The final crop was just over 90,000 tonnes more than the original forecast.

The CCS average for the season was 13.19 units and, while down on the previous season, is above the long-term average.

Members of the public should be aware that locomotive movements will remain in progress over the next week for cane bin maintenance requirements.

Many thanks go to Wilmar Sugar employees, cane growers and harvesting contractors for their hard work and co-operation during the 2020 season.
