At a glance

Wilmar Sugar and Renewables has two sugar mills in the Herbert region.

Our Macknade Mill was established in 1873, making it the oldest operating sugar mill in Queensland. Victoria Mill was established in 1883 and is one of the largest sugar mills in Australia, processing about three million tonnes of sugarcane each year.

The raw sugar manufactured at our Herbert mills is transported by rail to the Lucinda Terminal from where it is shipped to domestic and international customers.
