At a glance

Wilmar Sugar and Renewables has three sites in the Sarina region: Plane Creek Mill, Sarina Distillery and Oonooie fertiliser and stockfeed facility.

Plane Creek Mill was established in 1896 and produces raw sugar, molasses and renewable energy. It provides steam and power to the neighbouring bioethanol distillery, which started operating in 1927.

The Sarina Distillery is one of Australia's leading manufacturers of bioethanol, and the only large-scale producer of ethanol from molasses.

The distillery also produces dunder as a co-product of the ethanol distilling process. The dunder is piped to our Oonooie facility, where it is used as a base for renewable liquid fertiliser and stockfeed products.
