# Thursday, 28 September 2023

Our eight factories have processed **nine million tonnes** of cane, which represents **58 per cent** of the total forecast crop.

The declaration of an El Nino weather pattern means a reduced chance of a wet finish to the 2023 season.

However, the predicted drier, hotter conditions may cause cane yields to drop off, and have an adverse impact on next year's crop.

#### **HERBERT**

- Multiple transfers between factories to manage standover cane are creating logistical challenges and some cane supply gaps.
- Standover cane with low purity and CCS has hindered processing at both factories.
- Fine weather conditions continue to prevail, and CCS levels are on an upward trend.

### **BURDEKIN**

CCS this week	Tonnes to date	Per cent of total	Total BKN crop
15.56	4.97M	61 per cent	8.2 million tonnes

- Processing rates and factory reliability have been good.
- Dry conditions may soon impact the remaining crop.
- CCS levels are now running above budget.

#### **PROSERPINE**

CCS this week	Tonnes to date	Per cent of total	Total PRO crop
14.77	952,000	54 per cent	1.75 million tonnes

- Factory reliability has been strong, with more than 91,000 tonnes processed last week.
- CCS has been climbing steadily.
- Some light showers have occurred recently, but weather conditions have remained favourable overall.

## **PLANE CREEK**

CCS this week	Tonnes to date	Per cent of total	Total PCK crop
14.10	651,000	45 per cent	1.45 million tonnes

- CCS levels are remaining steady.
- The factory resumed operations today, after an extended stop to repair No.5 mill.
- Our maintenance and production teams continue to focus on improving factory reliability and rate.
