Comments:

We had our highest weekly throughput for the season to date with just shy of 400,000 tonnes of cane processed in a week that included a cleaning intermission at Pioneer Mill.

Well done to everybody who contributed to this strong result.

Average weekly CCS was 15.23, which is 0.7 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.00 from a rake of Q240 third ratoon cane supplied from the Upper Haughton productivity district.

Harvesting operators are again reminded to follow siding procedures when delivering or collecting bins. These procedures are designed to safeguard all users and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings

We still do not have full compliance with siding inductions, and we urge that you please check that all your operators have completed the mandatory siding induction.

Parents and carers are urged to warn their children about the dangers of walking, playing or riding near our cane rail network.

Cane trains can't swerve and they can't stop quickly. It's up to all of us to stay well clear of the cane rail network and always give way to cane trains.
