Comments:

The Burdekin mills have now passed the season halfway mark with just shy of 3.9M tonnes of cane processed.

Throughput for week 11 was just over 364,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a cleaning intermission at Inkerman and Invicta mills.

Average weekly CCS was 15.24, which is 0.6 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.20 from a rake of mixed first ratoon cane supplied from the Stockham Road productivity district.

With the high winds we have had several reports of uncontrolled empty bins. Please ensure bins in sidings are secured at all times.

Harvesting operators are again reminded to follow siding procedures when delivering or collecting bins. These procedures are designed to safeguard all users and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings.

Parents and carers are urged to warn their children about the dangers of walking, playing or riding near our cane rail network.

Please remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
